This is in response to your recent Notice of Preparation for an Environmental Impact Report for the Alameda Point project.

The Alameda Architectural Preservation Society requests that the city expand upon the "Historic Resources/Adaptive Reuse" section of the EIR to include a study of project alternatives that preserve more or all of the historic buildings and previously AAPS/ANAM identified contributing structures prioritized for adaptive reuse. SunCal was requested to complete, as a Non-Mandatory Milestone, a Historic Preservation and Adaptive Reuse Technical Analysis that may be helpful to comply with our request.

In addition, AAPS requests a plan be developed, and implemented, to secure the buildings as soon as possible to prevent further deterioration.
